SUMMARY OF INQUIRY INTO APPROVAL OF USE GILES COUNTY AGRI-PARK 2021 AND 2022 PRIDE EVENTS

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Key Takeaways From Inquiry Into Approval of Pride Events 2021 and 2022

There were interesting revelations as a result of the persistence to obtain this information. If anything said here is incorrect, it is a result of information withheld by the County Executive's office. Here are just some highlights:

- 1. There is no application to be completed to use County facilities. Only a call to the office and a person checks the calendar and writes it down if not already in use.
- 2. There is no permit issued or written approval given for use of the facilities.
- 3. There is no signed lease agreement for facility use. There is a written Facility Lease Agreement but it has no place for signatures, the event organizers do not sign a lease, and there is no lease to be retained on file. We are leasing facilities WITHOUT a SIGNED lease agreement. Any competent attorney knows better than to allow this to happen.
- 4. The Facility Lease Agreement references a document entitled "Giles County Agri Park Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations" yet no one can produce this document. There is no method for organizing and recalling documents with their latest revisions. The lease (that isn't signed) states that the lessee must follow all the rules in this document or the lease is terminated. The County Executive stated in this year's campaign debates that there was no alcohol present at this year's event. There is no rule against alcohol in the lease so where is this rule documented?
- 5. The Facility Lease Agreement clearly states that proof of insurance must be presented by the event organizer 48 hrs before the event and that the policy must name the county on the policy. If this document exists it must be maintained on file for 7 years according to State law and yet the County Executive has stated that proof of insurance for the 2021 Pride event does not exist. According to the event organizers they did not even know they needed insurance until after my records request was submitted to the County Executive. The County is at risk if there are any claims for the 2021 event. This also means that the organizers did not abide by the terms of the lease in 2021 and SHOULD NOT have been given permission to repeat the event in 2022 according to the Facility Lease Agreement. I did not request proof of insurance for this year's event yet the County Executive provided it and it was only provided because I requested last years records and the County Executive's office notified the event organizers.
- 6. Records from last year indicated that the County Executives office did not follow the rules then either as they collect \$400 in deposit but no additional funds and simply refunded the difference in the deposit and fees after the event. This is not according to the fee schedule and not how the 2022 event was handled AFTER the inquiry into the 2021 event. Once again, the CE was not following the rules.
- 7. There were no funds received for rents or deposits until 6 June, AFTER my records request which apparently prompted the CE office to notify the organizers of the need for a deposit. The event organizers stated they did not know they had to provide this deposit.
- 8. The Facility Lease Agreement states that advertising material for the event must be submitted yet there were no advertising materials submitted for either 2021 or 2022. This is a violation of the lease and the agreement should have been terminated under the rules of the lease. The CE did not follow the rules. The intent is obvious that the approval could be terminated if activities weren't deemed appropriate yet there is no evidence that the CE considered such materials.
- 9. The Facility Lease Agreement states there must be a printed report from the lessee following the event that includes the event name, date of event, where event was held, total number of participants and or spectators, list of fees charged and collected. The CE states that no such

document exists. Once again, the rules were not followed by the CE nor the event organizers and therefore approval should not have been granted this year either.

- 10. The CE did not seek legal advice until after my inquiry. She has also neglected to be fully transparent and reveal the full opinion of the District Attorney on this matter. The County Executive has claimed the DA agrees with her and that she is following the law. That is not true! The DA agrees that the state statute applies and that she could have denied the use of the park. The DA also requested from the County Attorney a signed lease and the rules and regulations of the park. The County Attorney did not supply the requested information. The County Executive is not providing the public with those pieces of information. The DA advised that after consulting with the Attorney General's office he advised the Sheriff's Department not to make arrests or attempt to shut down the event based solely on the violation of that statute but if additional laws were broken then appropriate action should be taken. The CE is not being fully transparent with the public.
- 11. The CE was absent from the office the entire week leading up to the event at the Agri Park and her own administrative assistance did not know her schedule or intended absences. She intentionally withheld all documents that actually existed until AFTER the event. On 8 June I was told by Angela Jernigan, administrative assistant, that the office had some of my requested documents but not all and Melissa Greene had told her not to give me any documents until they had all of them. This was not a legal requirement but a delay tactic.
- 12. The County Executive has cited the First Amendment as justification for granting approval for this year's Pride event at the Agri Park. The First Amendment does not provide the right for children to be present at a drag show and hand money to dancers. The First Amendment does not provide the right for a man to strip into his underwear and dance in front of children on County owned property. This occurred at the 2021 event and there is plenty of documentation to back up these claims. Texas has taken steps to prevent this from happening. Florida has legislation being introduced that will make it a FELONY to take a child to a drag show and includes the loss of parental rights! Tennessee will take up legislation in the next session related to this as well.
- 13. The DA agrees that the County Executive could have used existing state statute to reject the drag show. She chose not to and did not even seek legal counsel until after my inquiry. Something serious enough to warrant legislation that could result in a felony and loss of parental rights should be something that warrants the attention of the County Executive enough to seek legal authority to deny that type of activity. Due to her incompetence or agreement with the activity or possibly both, she has opened up the County to serious liability and has participated in the exposure of children to activity which will have permanent negative effect upon them. It is imperative that I bring this information forward in the interest of transparency and as a result of the inaction of the Commission to intervene and demand accountability from the County Executive's office.

Summary: The County Executive chose to IGNORE THE LAW! She has intentionally delayed providing records to the public even though they were available at the time. Her office has either not followed the rules by acquiring the proper documents from lessee's or has not retained those records in VIOLATION OF STATE LAW. The County Executive has left the County in a vulnerable position as a result of her actions.

Timeline of Events Related to 2022 Pride Event at the Agri Park

2 June	Personal email to the County Executive Melissa Greene imploring to deny approval for use of Agri Park for Pride Event
3 June	Response from CE that copied all Commissioners (that have email), Ag Park Committee, State Representative Clay Doggett, and State Senator Joey Hensley
3 June	Responded to the CE and cited the same Tennessee Code that the DA agreed applies and provides authority for the CE to deny use of the facility. (see attached email string)
	Also asked the CE: "What have you personally done to change the law if you don't believe this type of activity is illegal? How have you led to protect innocent children? Or do you agree with this type of activity taking place in our county owned facilities?"
	The CE never responded to these questions.
3 June	Requested rules of the Ag Park from CE in a new email
3 June	CE responded, "Angela Jernigan handles the Ag Park information. She's out today but will be back Monday and can send you the information. I've copied her on this email."
5 June	Responded to CE email regarding Angela Jernigan providing Ag Park rules with this message: "Do you not have a copy of the Ag Park rules? Please correct me if I am wrong but I thought you issued the permit to use the Ag Park for the Pride event on 11 June. If you approve Ag Park use I am certain you would have the regulations to ensure the use was proper before approving. Is this incorrect?
	Nevertheless, I am formally requesting a copy of the permit issued and the receipt for funds received from the event organizers. I will stop by your office tomorrow morning to pick up the copies along with the Ag Park rules if I have not received them electronically. Your answers to the above questions are appreciated. Thank you for your assistance in this matter."
	The CE never responded to this email.
6 June	Went to CE office in person. Spoke with Angela Jernigan, Administrative Assistant for CE. Submitted a records request as I indicated in 5 June email. Received a copy of the generic "Facility Lease Agreement". Left office and read agreement. Returned to office and requested the "Giles County Agri-Park Ordinances, Rules and Regulations" referenced in the lease. Angela said that Melissa would be in the office the next morning and she would ask her about it. (Full conversation documented)

7 June	Went to CE office in person again. Asked if Melissa was in as I had been told she would be. She was not present again. I asked for my requested records and they were not available yet. I added a request for additional records based upon a reading of the lease. This included proof of insurance for 2021. (Conversation fully documented)
7 June	CE was not in office but appeared at radio station for weekly spot and spoke to the issue of the event. In the same ad she stated that she was a "rules follower". She also admitted in that spot that my inquiries had sparked her to ask Lucy Henson to seek legal advice (note this is not prior to approval but AFTER my inquiry). She also stated, falsely, in that ad on the radio that the DA had said there was no legal way to stop the event. That was a lie. She also attended a committee meeting that evening.
7 June	Event organizers on social media asking for help with funds for a deposit and insurance which they did not know they needed to have.
7 June	Emailed CE again: "I assume my request for documentation (see attachments) over the last several days has prompted a request to the event organizers to provide additional funds and insurance. It appears the organizers were unaware of insurance until now (Please see attached post from one of the event organizers). I hope that you will provide my requested documentation very soon. You have addressed this publicly on the radio today and on Facebook live but have not responded to my last couple of emails requesting information related to the event. Your prompt attention to this matter is greatly appreciated."
	No reply from CE.
7 June	District Attorney requested signed lease agreement and rules of Agri Park from County Attorney (which was not provided because they do not exist)
7 June	District Attorney provided County Attorney with details of his conversation with the Sherriff's Department
8 June	Emailed CE again at lack of reply to previous email: "Another day has passed and you have not responded to my requests. I will be at your office tomorrow morning and I expect at a minimum that your office can find the time to produce a copy of the request and approval for the Pride event this weekend. At this point it is starting to look suspiciously as though your office is delaying this information intentionally. I hope that is not the case. Additionally, this is the third day in a row you have been unavailable to the public. Your office has fielded calls today and told the citizens that you were unavailable. Again, I will be at your office tomorrow morning with the expectation that you can produce the documentation. If this is the professional standard for your office then we have a problem and if this is a delay tactic then we have an even larger issue. Your prompt attention is appreciated."
	No reply from CE.
9 June	Went in person to CE office with 8 additional citizens and inquired about status of requested documentation. Angela Jernigan had been instructed by Melissa Greene to

not provided the available documentation. Angela also stated that there is no application to fill out, no approval given, and no signed lease for use of the Agri Park. Ashe stated the process has been only to call the office and ask for a date. If the date is available it is put on the calendar. Administrative Assistant (Angela) also stated that the CE would be back in the office in the afternoon though she didn't know what time. She assured me that CE would call me that afternoon when she got in the office.

CE NEVER called.

Julie Butler Philips in the Solid Waste Office called for a deputy to come over as "a large crowd was gathering". Officer Timothy Scott responded and acknowledged everything was appropriate. (entire event video recorded)

- 9 June Emailed CE again concerning her delay tactics (see attached string) and again no response from the CE.
- 10 June Emailed CE again over her lack of response and her deceiving the public on the radio (see attached string) and again no response from the CE.
- 10 June Admin Assistant not in office
- 11 June Event takes place
- 13 June 0828 hrs CE sent the attached documents. Only 20% of requested documents and including a document not requested were sent.

CE stated that no other documents existed.

- 16 June Requested names of members of Giles County Public Records Commission to investigate the matter.
- 17 June CE provided names of the Public Records Commission.

If the records you provided are the only records you can produce then I am very concerned about the competency of your leadership and the advice of the county attorney. Please provide the names of the 6 member County Public Records Commission, required by Tennessee law, as I believe it is very important that they investigate this matter further. Records from last year should still be retained according to CTAS which means that they never existed, a huge blunder took place in disposing of the documents, or once again you are covering up the inconvenient truth. Any competent attorney would have advised that an application process be implemented for leasing a county owned facility and would also know that a SIGNED lease agreement is necessary for the protection of all involved. There is no record of the event organizers providing insurance for last year's event. There could still be claims that the county would be liable for stemming from that event. Yet, we have no signed lease agreement and no proof of insurance. If this is the way we do business, our county is at risk and the county executive's office is a disgrace. I eagerly await your response as to the members of the County Public Records Commission and any clarification about the missing documentation.

Melissa,

Your continued lack of response should be a concern for every person on this email chain and for the public at large. Your admin said you would call me when you returned to the office yesterday afternoon and you did not call. She also doesn't even know your schedule. Are you remaining silent on advice of the county attorney or perhaps waiting for the written statement from the DA that you referenced in your radio ad on Tuesday? If you seek to provide full government transparency and not operate in the shadows then you would not try to slant the DA's response to try to bolster your argument that you have acted lawfully. Brent Cooper has agreed there was legal standing for you to refuse the organizers using the facility Saturday for the drag show portions. The guidance for law enforcement from the DA based upon the AG's office information should not be portrayed as endorsing the county executives office actions in approving the drag show. Once again, the facts. You gave approval before seeking the DA's opinion and sought a written statement to offer as cover for your actions. You could have sought for legal assistance in denying use if you felt this activity was inappropriate on county owned property. You did not. You either agree with the activity and are giving cover to the organizers or you made a mistake in not doing your due diligence. If the later is the case, you would be better off being honest rather than covering it up. You are deceiving the public and you are fully aware of what you are doing.

Your strategy appears to be (and yes, it is a strategy) to delay all requested records for this year's event until you get all your ducks in a row so you can go before the public and state how much of a rule follower you are. Conveniently, you will not produce the requested documents from 2021 with the justification that there is no time limit for how long you have to maintain those documents. The strategy is clear. The motivation is the murky part and I would hate to make assumptions or accusations in that regard. The interpretations of your actions, however, lead to very disturbing conclusions. I am confident further investigation in to your actions and the county attorneys actions is warranted.

You have stated repeatedly in your campaign that you are for ALL the people of Giles County. Well, I am one of those people and you are obviously not even responding to and you have used your admistrative assistance to stonewall as well. I sincerely hope you will have a change of heart and become FULLY transparent and not slant your message, that you will become responsive in a truthful way with me and others of the public, and you will act with integrity and leadership. If not, I hope everyone on this string will become concerned enough to demand corrective action as well. I truly wish I was wrong about what is happening because I love this community. But I am afraid I am not wrong.

As to your request to deny the "Pride" event at the Ag Park, I must disagree with your premise that this is not a First Amendment issue. But here's the thing, the Constitution doesn't provide freedoms and protections only to those that look like us or think like us or worship like us. Our Constitution provides those protections and freedoms to EVERY SINGLE AMERICAN CITIZEN. By your own statement, you know we will get sued because we would be breaking the law. I will not break the law.

As Harry Truman stated, "Once a government is committed to the principle of silencing the voice of opposition, it has only one way to go, and that is down the path of increasingly repressive measures, until it becomes a source of terror to all its citizens and creates a country where everyone lives in fear."

Lessee releases Giles County Agri-Park, its officers, employees, and agents and Giles County, Tennessee from personal liability and or any claim growing out of or concerning the making of this agreement. Lessee expressly assumes full responsibility for all persons connected with Lessees use of Premises, including all its employees, agents, members, invitees, and licensees. Lessee Hereby Agrees and Covenant with the Giles County Agri-Park to abide by the following:

Lessee agrees that all persons connected with Lessee occupancy and use of Premises under this agreement shall abide by, conform to, and comply with all the laws of the United States, and the State of Tennessee, and all the ordinances and polices of Giles County, Tennessee, and all Giles County Agri-Park Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations.

The lessee assumes full responsibility for all damages or destruction to property in the park during the event. This responsibility extends to personal injury as well as property damage on claims made by any group or individual.

Giles County Agri-Park reserves the right to terminate the Agreement at anytime the lessee fails to satisfy all the conditions or requirements of this Agreement.

Lessee will submit a printed copy to Giles County Agri-Park of all adverting materials prior to their release.

Lessee will submit a printed post event report. To including but not be limited to: event name, date of event, where event was held, total number of participants and or spectators, list of fees charged and collected.

All facility use fees owed to Giles County Agri-Park must be received forty-eight hours prior to the event and are non-refundable.

When applicable the Lessee will provide appropriate documentation of Non-Profit Status to Giles County Agri-Park.

All required insurance certificates (listing Giles County Agri-Park as Additional Insured) must be received forty-eight hours prior to the event.

When applicable the 25% gate fee will be paid to Giles County Agri-Park no later than ten business days following the event.

All contracted service fees pertaining to the event held in Giles County will be paid in a timely manner. Lessee will submit to a post event walk through of the premises. The walk through will be performed by and signed off on by a Giles County Agri-Park Maintenance employee or the Park Ranger.

Firearms, fireworks, explosives, paintball guns, remote control airplanes, weapons, paramilitary activities, combat games, and any dangerous projectiles are prohibited. Giles County, Tennessee does recognize a valid Tennessee Concealed Weapons Permit.

Lessee Hereby Agrees and Covenant with the Giles County Agri-Park to abide by the following:

Lessee agrees that all persons connected with Lessee occupancy and use of Premises under this agreement shall abide by, conform to, and comply with all the laws of the United States, and the State of Tennessee, and all the ordinances and polices of Giles County, Tennessee, and all Giles County Agri-Park Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations.

The lessee assumes full responsibility for all damages or destruction to property in the park during the event. This responsibility extends to personal injury as well as property damage on claims made by any group or individual.

Giles County Agri-Park reserves the right to terminate the Agreement at anytime the lessee fails to satisfy all the conditions or requirements of this Agreement.

Lessee will submit a printed copy to Giles County Agri-Park of all adverting materials prior to their release.

Lessee will submit a printed post event report. To including but not be limited to: event name, date of event, where event was held, total number of participants and or spectators, list of fees charged and collected.

All facility use fees owed to Giles County Agri-Park must be received forty-eight hours prior to the event and are non-refundable.

When applicable the Lessee will provide appropriate documentation of Non-Profit Status to Giles County Agri-Park.


All required insurance certificates (listing Giles County Agri-Park as Additional Insured) must be received forty-eight hours prior to the event.


When applicable the 25% gate fee will be paid to Giles County Agri-Park no later than ten business days following the event.
